



About LanguageCert International ESOL qualifications


LanguageCert International ESOL (English for Speakers of Other Languages) is a suite of English language qualifications that assesses English **communicative skills**. Exam tasks are suitable for ensuring students can use **all four language skills in academic and social environments**.

LanguageCert International ESOL is **level-based**, with its **six levels** corresponding to the Common European Framework of Reference (CEFR A1-C2). Students can book and prepare for the exam level they need. The LanguageCert B2 Communicator or C1 Expert exam is recommended for higher education studies at undergraduate and postgraduate levels.









Written and **Spoken** exam components for each level can be taken together on the same day or independently of each other, **leading to two separate certificates**. The total assessment time covering all four skills is approximately 3 hours (depending on the exam level).

The Speaking test is a 1:1 interactive session with a LanguageCert Interlocutor. The use of interlocutors for face to face and online speaking exams provides a much more authentic and realistic approach to speaking skills assessment.

How the exam is taken

Online with live proctoring anytime, anywhere (including at home)



How exams are marked

Exam marking is performed by LanguageCert trained markers and monitored by Chief Examiners to assure the highest security, validity, and reliability standards.

PeopleCert's PASSPORT® (PeopleCert Assessment Portal) digital platform. PASSPORT® is a proprietary, state-of-the-art, cloud-based exam management platform.

Through PASSPORT, markers view and assess scripts or exam items on the screen and enter the mark given for a question directly into the system. Exam markers cannot view candidate details, such as scripts or exam items, which are anonymous, further enhancing security.



International ESOL exam results

Candidates receive a score out of 50 for each skill: Listening, Reading, Writing and Speaking.

We also report an overall Grade for each exam which appears on the Statement of Results and Certificates. Overall Grades are reported as High Pass, Pass or Fail.

Most institutions set a minimum score requirement for each skill, e.g. LanguageCert C1 Expert with a minimum of 25/50 in each skill.

The table below illustrates how the scores sit within each CEFR level, i.e. aligning to the bottom, the middle and top range within each CEFR level.


UKVI SELT Results: for students who need to take the test as a SELT for UK visa purposes, a minimum score of 33/50 is required for each skill. The Test Report for SELT tests does not provide a Grade result.

Online Results Verification

LanguageCert offers a Results Verification Service that allows institutions to access and verify a student's Statement of Results or Test Reports for SELT results. This service ensures the authenticity of exam results and certificates.

Alternatively, students can email their results automatically and securely from their online account directly to the institution for instant review.

LanguageCert Statement of Results


The Statement of Results (SoR) is provided upon release of official exam results and is available through the LanguageCert candidate account. An automatic email notification is sent to inform test takers that the SoR is available.

Test takers receive separate SoRs for written and spoken exams (that is two separate score reports)

The SoR is intended to provide useful information on exam performance, including a score per skill as well as an overall Grade result. For example, if a test taker has taken the LanguageCert International ESOL Written exam, they will be provided with a score for each of the skills assessed: Listening, Reading and Writing as well as an overall Grade result of Fail, Pass or High Pass.

The SoR can also be forwarded automatically through the LC candidate account to 3rd parties that require proof of the test taker's English language proficiency. All the information institutions need to verify results through the LanguageCert website can be found on the SoR.
