# What makes LANGUAGECERT Academic relevant for higher education?

- 1. The contexts focus on language used in an academic environment, with academic vocabulary and expressions relevant to most subjects. The test contains scenarios which include discussions with tutors, fellow students or university officials, lectures, seminars as well as authentic academic source materials (articles, journals, reports).
- **2.** The tasks sample features of language and skills from those required to succeed in an academic setting, e.g., writing essays, giving presentations, note-taking, formulating arguments.

## LANGUAGECERT Academic test format and structure

LANGUAGECERT Academic assesses 4 skills (Listening, Reading, Writing, and Speaking) through a Written and a Spoken component. **Both components must be booked together, and can be taken on the same day or within 14 days of each other**. Both the Written and Spoken components are available through the LANGUAGECERT Secure Test Centre network, and via Online Proctoring.
