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1. Introduction

The LANGUAGECERT Young Learners (Fox and Owl) Vocabulary List gives teachers a guide to the vocabulary needed when preparing students for the LANGUAGECERT Young Learners (Fox and Owl) examinations.

Background to the list

LANGUAGECERT's Young Learners ESOL qualifications (Fox and Owl) are a suite of English language exams specifically designed for younger learners aged seven to twelve. They are aimed to motivate and encourage candidates while also measuring their level and abilities.

Young Learners Fox and Owl qualifications are targeted at Pre-A1 and A1 levels respectively. There are separate written and spoken exams for each qualification which test candidates' listening, reading, writing, and speaking skills. These exams are developed using language from the LANGUAGECERT Young Learners (Fox and Owl) Vocabulary List.

The LANGUAGECERT Young Learners (Fox and Owl) Vocabulary List is provided here as a useful resource for teachers preparing students for LANGUAGECERT'S Young Learners ESOL qualifications.

How the list is updated

The LANGUAGECERT Young Learners (Fox and Owl) Vocabulary List is a dynamic word list. It is compiled using LANGUAGECERT's in-house vocabulary list and is reviewed and revised annually by LANGUAGECERT's team of language experts.

2. Organisation of the List

The LANGUAGECERT Young Learners (Fox and Owl) Vocabulary List is divided between two alphabetical lists of Fox (Pre-A1) and Owl (A1) words or phrases and appendices, which cover Word Sets and Topic Lists. The lists do not include every word that may appear on LANGUAGECERT Young Learners Fox or Owl exam papers. The lists cover receptive and productive vocabulary.

Alphabetical Lists

The lists show words and phrases in alphabetical order, along with an adjoining abbreviation indicating the part of speech they belong to.

Exemplification

Example phrases and sentences showing how words might be used are given only where words with different meanings need to be constrained. For example, 'light' is followed by 'not dark' – this shows that 'light' is limited to the idea of colour: candidates are not expected to know other meanings, such as 'not heavy'.

Phrasal verbs

All phrasal verbs (that is, multi-word verbs) which Young Learners candidates might be expected to know are included in the list.

Unsuitable topics

LANGUAGECERT English examinations do not contain anything which might offend or upset candidates, potentially affect their performance, or distract them during the examination. A number of 'sensitive' topics are considered unsuitable for use in LANGUAGECERT Young Learner exams – for example, war and politics – and the vocabulary relating to these is not included in the list.
